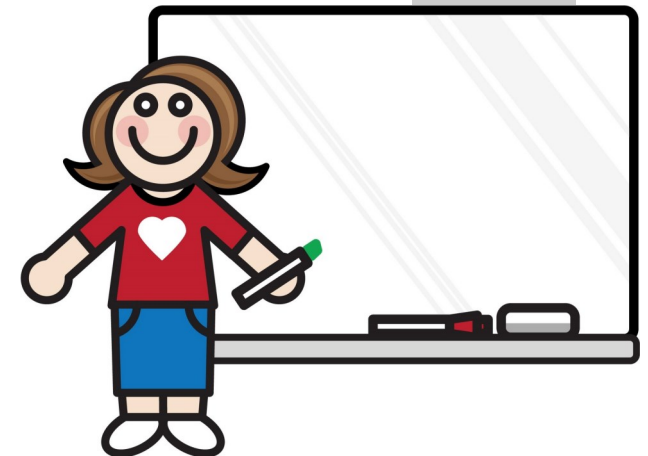

- * Completed 250 word essay which answers the question, "Why Am I the Best Student Teacher for this Mentorship?"
- * Praxis Content Area tests completed
