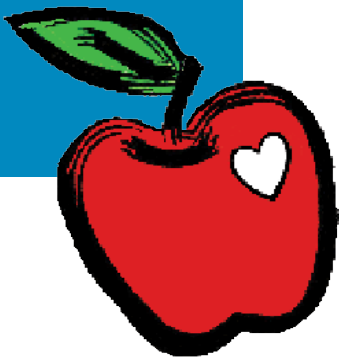

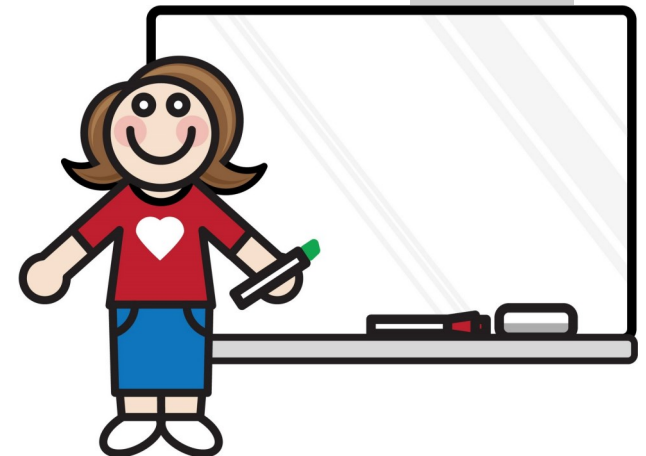

### What is a Mentorship???

Students selected for the program are provided the opportunity to partner with, and learn from, a Hall of Fame teacher with 20+ years of classroom experience.

- \* Accepted into Block 3/Phase II for Spring 2023
- \* Reference letter from one content area professor
- \* Be willing to travel out of Kansas
- \* In good standing with Emporia State University
- \* Evidence of maturity and leadership
- \* Complete the Application
- \* Complete 250 word essay which answers the question, "Why Am I the Best Student Teacher for this Mentorship?"
- \* Pass Praxis II Content Area and Pedagogy tests
