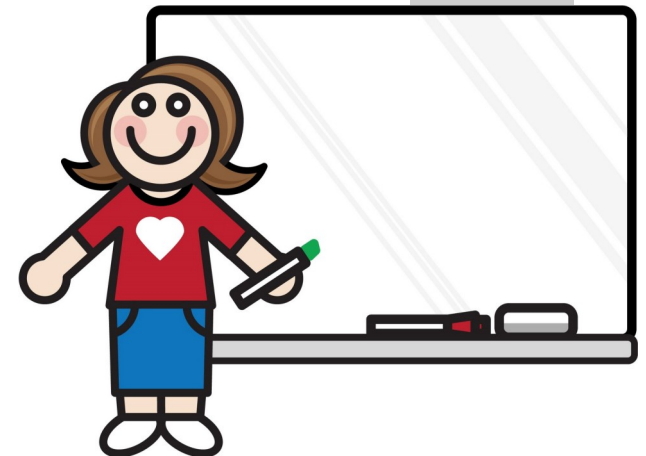

What is a Mentorship???

This mentorship program is an innovative four-week experience designed to inspire new teachers to view their classroom through the eyes of a career educator. Students selected for the program are provided the opportunity to partner with, and learn from, a Hall of Fame teacher with 20+ years of classroom experience.

- * Accepted into Block 3/Phase II for Fall 2023
- * Reference letter from one content area professor
- * Be willing to travel out of Kansas
- * In good standing with Emporia State University
- * Evidence of maturity and leadership
- * Complete the Application
- * Complete 250 word essay which answers the question, "Why Am I the Best Student Teacher for this Mentorship?"
- * Pass Praxis II Content Area and Pedagogy tests
